

CAMBRIDGE JUNIOR CHESS AND GO CLUB: Constitution

1. The purpose of the club is to encourage children of school age in and around Cambridge to play chess and go and to raise their awareness of other classic strategy board games. The club will organise activities involving the playing of (fairly equally) chess and go and (to a lesser degree) some other traditional games.
2. Children become members of the club by attending a meeting and having a membership form filled in by a parent or guardian. They remain members as long as they wish to, so long as they keep attending the club.
3. The committee shall consist of:
 - * Up to 2 members nominated by Cambridge University Go Society
 - * Up to 4 Parents' Representative volunteers (elected at the AGM if there are more volunteers than places)
 - * Up to 2 other co-opted members who may be Chess teachers or other helpers at the club
4. The committee shall be responsible for organising the club's activities and shall set the level of weekly subscription paid by members to attend the club's regular meetings.
5. An AGM shall be held each year, normally in the summer term. Those eligible to attend this meeting and vote on any proposals are the current committee and the parents of current members of the club. At the AGM, the committee shall report on the activities and finances of the club during the year.
6. Any change to the constitution or purpose of the club must be agreed by a vote at the club AGM and must also be approved by Cambridge University Go Society.
7. If the club closes down, any remaining assets shall become the property of Cambridge University Go Society, if it is still operating.
8. This constitution is effective from 1 November 2017 and supersedes all previous constitutions of the club.
